The Diaspora Day is one of the engagement tools designed by the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria for bringing its Diaspora home annually. The Diaspora Day takes place on 25 July and is a platform for dialogue on national development of Nigeria. From its vantage point, the Diaspora come home to meet with practitioners from public and private sector as well as the civil society organisations. Science and Technology has to a large extent been the major focus of the Diaspora Day since inception. In recent years, Nigerians in Diaspora Organisation (NIDO) has advocated for project-based Diaspora Day with job creation as the ultimate deliverable.

Objectives of Diaspora Day 2013
